Packaging

All Innova framed mirrors have dual packaging to enable all types of retail exposure.

Each mirror is first individually packed with heavy duty corner protection and shrinkwrapped, then further packed into individual cartons. This is to ensure safe transportation all the way to you and then to the end consumer.

All Innova frameless mirrors come with plastic corner caps and shrinkwrapping.

Each carton also has a colour label showing the product inside to minimise handling of the product.

All cartons are also marked "Fragile".

All Innova mirrors wherever possible have a maximum carton weight of 20kg. The majority of the product cartons are adapted to fit optimal pallet despatches.

All shrinkwrap is made of polypropylene and no PVC is used for packaging.

Each step of production of Innova mirrors, from raw material to finished product, has been subject to strict quality control.

Innova mirrors meet with BS EN 14749:2005 and BS 7449:1991 standards.



Glass and Hangers

Innova use quality mirror glass 3,4 or 5mm thick.

Bevelling is between 10 and 25mm wide, mainly 25mm on larger mirrors. All exposed glass edges are polished.

All mirrors have pre-fitted heavy duty hangers for portrait or landscape hanging where applicable.

All mirrors come with hanging instructions for safe hanging.

Wood and MDF

All wood used is chain of custody verified and from managed forests.

All MDF is made to the EU compliant E1, E1 and E0 standards, fulfilling minimum use of formaldehyde content.
